VITA/BIO

Bernd Haas

Bernd Haas was born in Innsbruck in 1979 and began his music education with the study of guitar at the age of nine at the local music school in Silz in the Upper Inn Valley. During his young years he switched from acoustic to electric guitar and found his way into rock music. Simultaneously he gathered his first experiences in live performance with a variety of bands. At the age of seventeen, the jazz bug bit him and a new chapter in his musical evolution opened. Projects revolving around Wolfi Mayr, guitarist, singer and blues harp player; the big impact of Stefan Wolf, his former guitar teacher; and a year of private instruction under the aegis of Roland Heinz reinforced his desire to study jazz guitar under Martin Nitsch at the State Conservatory of Tyrol, from which he graduated in 2004. In 2021 he commenced studies in classical guitar at the Mozarteum Salzburg/Innsbruck, graduating with a Bachelor of Arts Degree with Distinction in 2016.

After masterclasses with Barry Harris, Kenny Werner, Wolfgang Muthspiel and Tuck Andress he finally studied with Peter O'Mara (at the University of Music and Performing Arts Munich) to complete university studies in Jazz Guitar with a Master Degree in 2023.

Since completing his studies, Bernd Haas has taught classic and electric guitar at Tiroler Musikschulwerk, among other venues, and has been a freelance artist in music genres ranging from jazz to rock for more than twenty years. He has continued untiringly to study the most far-reaching aspects of music including composition, concepts of improvisation, musicology, instrumentation science, and has researched various guitar techniques (electric, classic, twelve-string guitar, flamenco guitar) while at the same time focusing on audio production at his own sound studio. He has also experimented with effect-generating devices which he developed himself in order to achieve the sound and/or resonance ideals he envisioned. His work extends from solo chamber music all the way to music performed by large-scale ensembles. He composes, arranges and produces music for a vast spectrum of bands, films and cabaret. Numerous recordings of his are available on CD.

Bernd Haas lives with his family in Innsbruck, Austria.
